

Please note!

Medical insurance policy should contain:

1. contract date;
2. policy number;
3. name, last name and patronymic (if applicable) of the policy holder;
4. details of the insurer;
5. the policy must be valid during the whole stay in the Russian Federation in case of a single- or double-entry visa and during the period of the first travel in case of a multiple-entry visa;
6. list of medical and transportation services including repatriation of remains;
7. coverage territory – the whole world or the Russian Federation; Europe, including Russia;
8. signature of the insurer.

Insurance policies, letters of confirmation from insurance organizations not containing the above-mentioned information, standard forms with stamps of insurance companies and other insurance documents not corresponding to the indicated requirements will not be accepted.

For a multiple-entry visa valid for one year or more an applicant must submit a medical insurance policy valid for the planned entry/entries into the Russian Federation. Absence of insurance policy may serve as grounds for imposition of administrative sanctions and denial of entry to the Russian Federation.
